5. The Court voted to accept the July, 2019 Financial Summary report of the County Treasurer and the July 9, 2019 minutes of the meeting of the Coryell County Historical Commission after a motion by Commissioner Kyle Matthews and a second by Commissioner Daren Moore. (Attached)

6. The Court voted to approve the minutes of Commissioner's Court meeting held on August 12, 2019 after a motion by Commissioner Don Jones and a second by Commissioner Kyle Matthews.

7. Justin Latham, Road and Bridge Administrator's gave a verbal "Daily Work History".

8. The Court voted to approve the appointment of Election Judges submitted by the County Election Official, Justin Carothers after a motion by Commissioner Don Jones and a second by Commissioner Daren Moore. (Attached)

11. The court voted to approve a Court Order No. 2019-01 "Order Prohibiting and Restricting Outdoor Burning" after a motion by Commissioner Kyle Matthews and a second by Commissioner Daren Moore.

12. An update on the County Courthouse Roof Repairs was given.

13. The "FY 20 Interlocal Agreement Heart of Texas Auto Theft Task Force ABTPA Contract #608-20-0270000" in the amount of \$46,603.00 was approved after a motion by Commissioner Kyle Matthews and a second by Commissioner Daren Moore. (Unsigned copy attached)

14. The court discussed an Analysis of the needs on construction of a new jail facility stating Commissioner Kyle Matthews reported the need for a jail and that the county owned property available near TDCJ.


