ORDER SUSPENDING COURT ORDER CC25-10 – LOCAL BURN BAN

*WHEREAS*, the Commissioners Court of Coryell County passed and approved Order CC25-10 on November 12, 2025, which prohibited the outdoor burning of brush, trash and debris in the unincorporated areas of Coryell County; and,

*WHEREAS*, the County Judge is authorized to make a determination, and now finds that environmental circumstances have changed to such a degree that the responsible burning of brush, trash and debris outdoors does not currently create a public safety hazard; therefore,

**IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** by the County Judge of Coryell County that Court Order CC25-10 be suspended, effective at 8:00am on Tuesday, November 25, 2025.

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that all applicable State statutes remain in effect and are enforceable. This includes, but not limited to, restrictions on outdoor burning when winds are predicted to exceed 23mph.
