The Coryell County Commissioners' Court convened at 8:30 a.m. with a quorum present to hold a workshop. County Judge Roger Miller Presided. Judge Miller led the Invocation and the Pledge to the American and Texas Flags.

4. A Workshop: Employee Compensation Review:

(a) Analysis Model

(b) Wages

1. The court discussed the current starting salaries.
2. The difference between current offices longevity Salary Schedules.

(c) Benefits:

1. Health Care was discussed with 193 employees enrolled and 30 not taking advantage. The court discussed the current Scott and White Plan and a plan offered by the Texas Association of Counties.
2. Paid Time Off was discussed.
3. Travel Expenses for continuing education and other types of travel by employees.

Retirement: The County requires each employee to contribute 7% to their retirement account. The county currently donates 1.65% to each employee retirement account.

4. The Court Voted to pass "Coryell County Resolution NO. 2019-05" to designate Coryell County Judge Roger Miller as the grantee's authorized official after a motion by Commissioner Kyle Matthews and a second by Commissioner Ray Ashby.
