DECLARING A LOCAL STATE OF DISASTER

WHEREAS, Coryell County due to prolonged flooding starting on October 13, 2018 has suffered widespread or severe damage, injury, or loss of property (or there is imminent threat of same) resulting from the prolonged flooding has exceeded the County's capabilities to protect the citizens, property and infrastructure; and

WHEREAS, the County Judge of Coryell County has determined that extraordinary measures must be taken to alleviate the suffering of people and to protect or rehabilitate property.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED BY THE JUDGE OF CORYELL COUNTY:

That a local state of disaster is hereby declared for the County of Coryell, Texas pursuant to §418.108(a) of the Texas Government Code.

Pursuant to §418.108(b) of the Texas Government Code, the state of disaster shall continue for a period of not more than seven days from the date of this declaration, unless the same is continued or renewed by the consent of the Commissioners' Court of Coryell County, Texas.

Pursuant to §418.108(c) of the Texas Government Code, this declaration of a local state of disaster shall be given prompt and general publicity and shall be filed promptly with the COUNTY CLERK.

Pursuant to §418.108(d) of the Texas Government Code, this declaration of a local state of disaster activates the CORYELL COUNTY Emergency Management Plan.

That this proclamation shall take effect immediately from and after its issuance.
